While each session focuses on a different discipline, activities will be tailored to each rider’s abilities, giving every rider a safe, yet challenging, experience! Our small size and excellent staff, horses and programs insure a positive educational experience—balancing morning and afternoon mounted instruction with lectures and demonstrations and lots of fun!

We are pleased to offer a Counselor In Training (CIT) Program for advanced riders at least 14 years old who have attended the Cornerstone Summer Riding Program in the past. CIT campers assist with lessons in the morning and participate in special CIT activities in the afternoon.

We will also be offering a Residence Camp for female campers during Sessions 4, 6 and 8. Residence campers participate in extra riding activities, as well as assisting in the care of our horses. Residence campers reside in an apartment in our personal residence with private bath, cable TV and pool.

Day Camp sessions run from Monday to Friday, 9:30 am-3:30 pm (extended day-8 am– 5 pm). Residence campers should plan on arriving a little early on Monday and pickup is on Friday afternoon at 4:30.

SESSION 1 (June 27-July 1)- Horse

Health Week– In addition to improving riding skills, we will be learning more about the health and care of horses! There will be special visits from the veterinarian, farrier and equine dentist!

SESSION 2 (July 5-8)- Camping Adventure Week

– There’s no camp on July 4, but we’ll make up for it with an overnight camping adventure during the week!

SESSION 3 (July 11-15)- “Extreme

Challenge” Week– Our focus this week will be on improving communication with our horse, encouraging him to be more responsive in preparation for the “Extreme Challenge” Race on Friday!

SESSION 4 (July 18-22)- Hunter-**

Jumper Week– Riders will work to improve equitation over stadium and cross-country courses, practice gymnastics in a jumping chute and learn the differences between hunter and jumper classes. On Friday, riders will compete in a mini-Hunter show.

SESSION 5 (July 25-29)- Drill Team

Week– Riders will plan and choreograph a Musical Drill Team performance– choosing music, costumes and movements– then practice and perform at the Foster Old Home Days Open Horse Show on Saturday, July 30th!

SESSION 6 (August 1-5)- Eventing Week-**

The sport of Combined Training includes tests in dressage, cross-country and stadium jumping– and we’ll be practicing all three! The highlight will be a mini-event at the Farm on Friday!

SESSION 7 (August 8-12)- Gymkhana Week-

In addition to our lessons, we’ll be practicing “mounted games of skill and speed”. On Friday, we’ll enjoy Barrel Racing, Pole Bending and more at the Cornerstone Gymkhana!

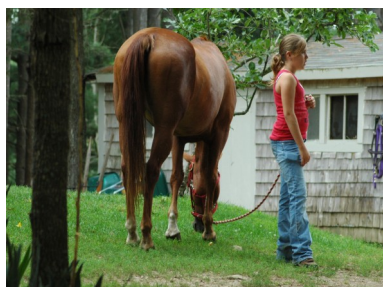
SESSION 8 (August 15-19)- Horse Show**
